

Afghan Altruistic Humanitarian Organization (AAHO)

Maximum Impact Donation Policy

1. Purpose

This policy outlines the principles and guidelines that govern the acceptance, use, and management of donations made to AAHO. Our aim is to ensure transparency, accountability, and responsible stewardship of all contributions.

2. Voluntary Nature of Donations

All donations to AAHO are voluntary and made without expectation of return. Donations are non-refundable once received.

3. Source of Funds

Donors confirm that they are the rightful owners of the funds donated. Donations must be derived from legitimate and legal sources.

4. Acceptance of Donations

AAHO reserves the right to accept or refuse any donation at its sole discretion. Donations that conflict with AAHO's values, mission, or legal obligations may be declined or returned.

5. Use of Donations

AAHO is committed to ensuring that the maximum possible portion of your donation is used directly for humanitarian programs including healthcare, education, and community development. A small percentage may be used for essential operational costs necessary to deliver aid effectively.

6. Donor Privacy

Donor information will be kept strictly confidential and will not be shared with third parties without consent. AAHO complies with applicable Dutch and European Union data protection laws (GDPR).

7. Tax Considerations

Donations may be tax-deductible depending on the donor's country of residence and applicable laws. Donors are advised to consult their tax advisor regarding deductibility.

8. Transparency & Accountability

AAHO maintains clear financial records and ensures transparent reporting of how donations are utilized. Annual reports reflect the use of funds and program outcomes.

9. Governing Law

This policy and all donations are governed by the laws of the Netherlands in accordance with applicable European Union regulations. Any disputes will fall under the jurisdiction of Dutch courts.

10. Amendments

AAHO reserves the right to amend this policy at any time. Updated policies will be posted on the AAHO website and take effect immediately upon publication.
